In a lively Q&A session, students who answered correctly were awarded ballpoints by Hanif Ahmad Khan, promoting engagement and participation.








Date: DEC 7, 2024

Our plan of action consisted of daily training sessions for small groups, precisely 10 trainees from a single the village each day. During each session, we taught participants how to convert kitchen waste into compost. To encourage active engagement and implementation of the composting process, we gave each participant a dustbin so they could put what they learnt into practice right away.

Over the first three days, we successfully educated 30 participants, providing them with the knowledge and resources they need to start composting in their own homes. To make the sessions more interesting, we offered participants with refreshments, each of which cost 200 PKR and included a burger, a shami kabab, and a juice slice.

Moving forward, we plan to maintain this method, delivering workshops daily and reaching a total of 70 individuals over seven days. This step-by-step method ensures a complete understanding and application of composting procedures, promoting environmental awareness and sustainable waste management at the community level.

The Chief Commissioner assured the YAPD team of any kind of collaboration and support in the future.





Disaster management was also discussed, focusing on effective ways individuals can contribute to mitigating climate change and disaster risk reduction.






Youth Delegation Visits to District Police Office Khyber

The YAPD delegation appreciated the Governor's efforts toward promoting education and development in the region and expressed hope for continued support for the youth of the tribal areas.





Educational visit to Peshawar Museum
